March Madness Deep Discussions! Poet and spiritual advisor Mark Nepo writes: "Unconditional love is not so much about how we receive and endure each other, as it is about the deep vow to never . . . stop bringing the flawed truth of who we are to each other." We tend to be hesitant about asking the deep questions we have about our spirituality for fear we'll be judged. This Lent, I invite you to take a risk and bring those questions to the next March Madness discussion on March 27 at 6 p.m.

The Lenten discussion of the book *Freeing Jesus: Rediscovering Jesus as Friend, Teacher, Savior, Lord, Way and Presence* by Diana Butler Bass, led by Pastor Katie, finishes March 24.
